### Special Update

#### Provisional thresholds from 1 January 2008

The two-yearly revision of the Public Procurement Directives thresholds by the EU Commission has resulted in a reduction in the thresholds for advertising in the Official Journal of the European Union that applied up to 31 December 2007. The revision is provided for in the Directives and the purpose is to keep the EU thresholds in alignment with those of the WTO's Government Procurement Agreement (GPA).

The changes applicable from 1 January 2008 to the main thresholds (exclusive of VAT) are as follows:

#### Public Sector

Supplies and Part A Services (except R&D, and certain telecom services):

Primarily Central Government and Associated Bodies - £90,319

Primarily Local Government and Associated Bodies - £139,893

Part B Services and R&D, and certain telecom services and subsidised services (regulation 34):

All Bodies - £139,893

Works:

All Bodies - £3,497,313

Small Lots:

Supplies and Services - £54,327

Works - £679,090

All Sectors - £279,785

Works:

All Sectors - £3,497,313

Small Lots:

Supplies and Services - £54,327
